Saturn Square Neptune Eh?

A September 10, 2016 waning square between Saturn and Neptune is the last of three face offs between these two planetary players before a 2026 conjunction renews an approximate 36 year, long cycle. Old man Saturn uncomfortable in restless, inspired Sagittarius has been working hard to constrain and control Neptune's dreamy illusions of cosmic oneness in the sign of its dignity, Pisces. Collectively, Canadians have responded to the square's tensions through shifts in the shared areas of government and culture unique to its national character and history.

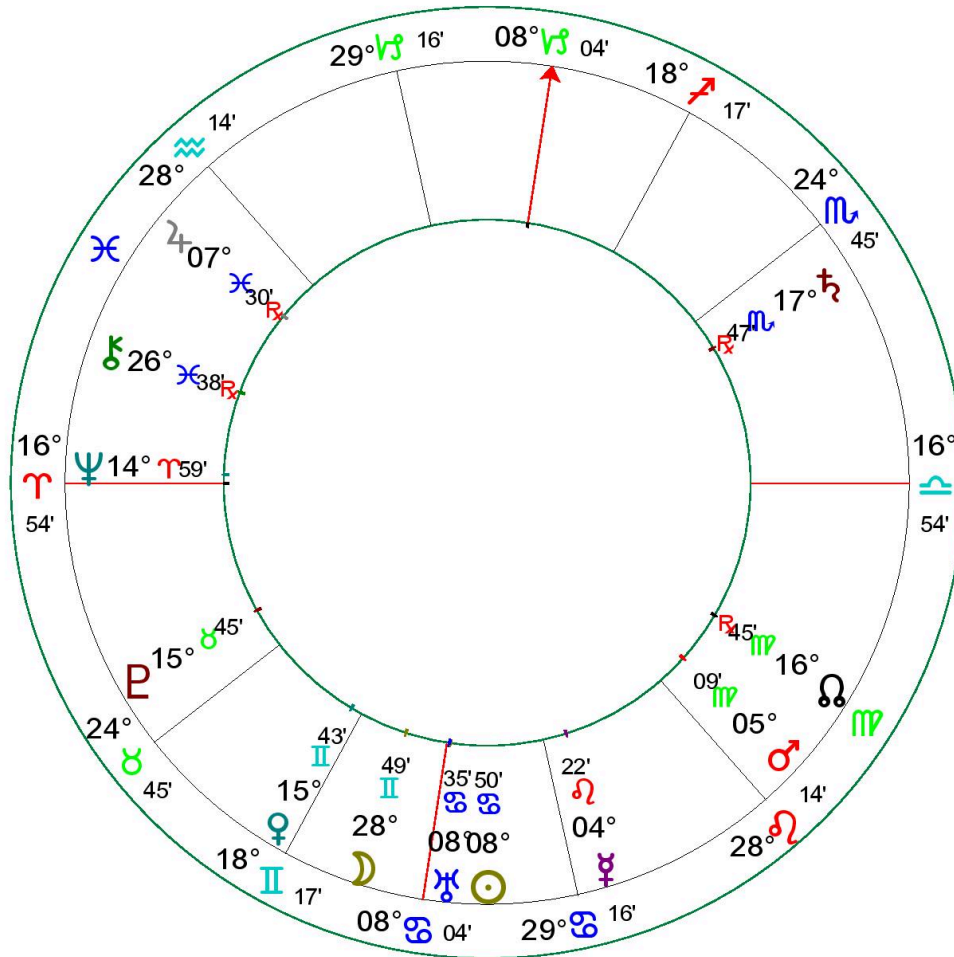
In the summer of 2015, the world watched as over a million migrants fleeing economic and civil unrest crossed the Mediterranean and Aegean Seas to the perceived safety of Europe. Testing physical boundaries and constitutional authority, these victims many from war torn Syria experienced varying amounts of compassion and disillusionment; all Saturn square Neptune themes. Canadians in the middle of a federal election awoke on September 2nd to see the searing image of Alan Kurdi, age 3 washed up on a Turkish shore. His mother and an older sibling were among those drowned. His father, Abdullah had survived but the dream of joining his sister Tima living outside of Vancouver, BC was over. BC Premier

Christie Clark gave voice to what many around the country believed true, "We have a uniquely Canadian duty to share the luck... and make sure that children and families like Alan Kurdi's find their way to Canada, so they don't have to face that kind of distress, that kind of loss."¹

The October 19th federal election ended Stephen Harper's conservative government, originally voted into power as Saturn and Neptune moved into opposition in the summer of 2006. Voters registered their disillusionment over many issues surrounding the 11 week campaign, including the Duffy Trial, the niqab ban and the Syrian refugee crisis. Change was in the air, and the new liberal Prime Minister, Justin Trudeau in a CBC interview of November 24th answered with his government's intentions of settling 25,000 Syrian refugees: "This is not just about welcoming 25,000 Syrian refugees, it's welcoming in 25,000 new Canadians."²

Over 300 communities from coast to coast put out the welcome mat, while over 10,000 refugees were matched with private individual and group sponsors eager to introduce them to hockey, double-doubles and maple syrup. As of August 2016, Trudeau's

liberal refugee policy has been a hard won success, with over 29,000 new Canadians settling in.¹

The unique Canadian response to the Syrian refugee crisis weaves seamlessly with the country's nativity and ongoing astro-development. The Dominion of Canada was born on July 1, 1867, in the capital city of Ottawa, a legal entity at 12:00 am. Seven natal planets lie below the horizon, giving credence to the quiet, interior Canadian persona that is never as loud as the

neighbor's down south. The natal chart is bucket shaped with Saturn serving as the isolated handle.

With a fourth house Sun in Cancer conjunct with Uranus, deep attachment to the land and its mysteries merge with an independent and quirky nature. A third house balsamic Moon in Gemini signifies the transformative power of shared resources such as education, a dual language identity, a deep appreciation of literature and other technical,

communitive arts. Also in Gemini, a second house Venus enjoys spending resources on the arts and shared social pleasures developed in the third. Mercury in Leo lies in the fifth house, supporting once again the creative side of life and underlying the importance of children and their development in the nation's psyche.

A twelfth house Neptune conjuncts the ascendant, both in active, independent Aries, suggesting a public persona bursting with humanitarian energy in the best of times, contrasting with confusion, blurred identity and victimization in the worst. An intercepted Jupiter in Pisces joins Neptune in the twelfth, underlying the importance of higher law and the need for justice in areas society would prefer to keep hidden. Joining Jupiter and Neptune in the uterine waters of the 12th house, intercepted Chiron reminds modern citizens of wounds delivered to the many indigenous communities incorporated into the modern nation and the role of reconciliation in public policy. Contrasting Jupiter is an intercepted, analytical sixth house Mars in Virgo underscoring the public's inchoate demand for health care and other civil services that fill society's general needs.

A first house Pluto in steady, determined Taurus speaks to public regeneration in times of national disaster or crisis. Seventh house Saturn in Scorpio opposes Pluto, indicating an intense, duty driven identity in foreign affairs. With Neptune's location so close to the ascendant and Saturn's isolation in the global identity of the seventh, any transits or progressions to these sensitive points will challenge

Canadians' sense of self and their place in the larger international community.

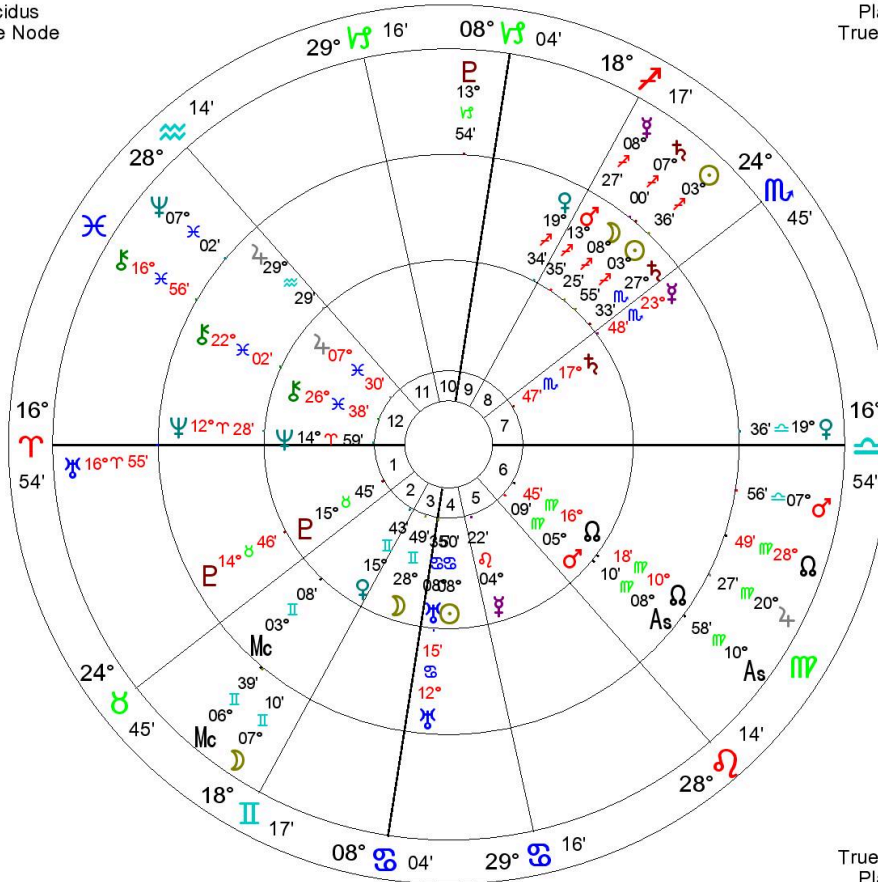
On November 26, 2015, Saturn and Neptune formed the first of three waning squares, shown in the outer ring of the Canadian tri-wheel. Allowing for a seven degree orb, the archetypal energies of this aspect began to rumble in the collective unconscious beginning in the spring of 2015 and will continue through the spring of 2017. This three stage waning square maturely integrates the newborn energies of the Saturn and Neptune conjunction in Capricorn of 1989. Saturn demands form and mastery, while Neptune fades and dissolves the earthly realities into a shared unity and idealism. Together this odd couple reforms the dreams of an inherently imperfect society into concretized form.

Transiting through the eighth house in the sign of Sagittarius, Saturn in November 2015 teamed with quick footed Mercury and the Sun to form a conjunction with the progressed Sun, new Moon and Mars also in Sagittarius. Energies break down, reform and rebuild in the hidden watery depths of the eighth, and the Canadian psyche reworked it's concept of life's mysteries: living, dying, and the use of resources and shouldering of debt for the benefit of the many.

In humanitarian Pisces, transiting Neptune joined and enhanced twelfth house natal Jupiter. The twelfth house recalls the nation's inheritance, its greatest strength and its greatest weakness. With timely cosmic synchronicity, Canadians recalled the years 1979-1980, when they welcomed 50,000 Vietnamese, Cambodian and Laos Boat People to their shores.

Similarly, in September 1979 through June 1980, a waning Saturn Neptune square formed, weaving the experience of those years into the fabric of the current Syrian refugee crisis. In September of '79, transiting Neptune in Sagittarius moved through the eighth and into the ninth house of the national chart, forming a trine with Canada's natal Neptune in Aries placed in the twelfth. An unimpeded humanitarian response meshing civil servants with private citizens concretized

the practical demands of a sixth house Saturn in Virgo. "It was a rare time in Canadian history," the former immigration minister Ron Atkey said. "What permitted this to go ahead was a genuine change of heart by the Canadian community."³

A year has passed since the fateful summer of 2015, and Abdullah Kurdi remains in northern Iraq, while a brother, Mohammed and his family have temporarily

settled in a group home for Syrian refugees in Vancouver's downtown core, close to their Canadian aunt, Tima. Permanent housing eludes them in the notoriously expensive metro area as does steady employment for Mohammed. Their five children prepare for a new school year, with the eldest daughter, 16 year old Heveen planning to become a dentist, while her brother, 15 year old Shergo hopes to become a police officer.⁴

Canadians recently settled or here for generations, will continue to wrestle with the many challenges that Saturn and Neptune pose as the pair move towards completion of this cycle to the beginning of another in February 2026. At that time, Saturn conjuncts Neptune in the dynamic zero degree of Aries, locating the two in Canada's twelfth house. In the light of day, the oceanic waters of the nation's twelfth house reflect the peoples' dreams and humanitarian visions, while in the shadow lurks the illusion of utopian solutions and possible martyrdom.

Looking back, Neptune transited the nation's twelfth house at zero degrees of Aries in April of 1861. It was around this time that Canadian citizens were protesting against the extradition of an escaped American slave, John Anderson.⁵ Anderson's case supported the strong abolitionist beliefs many individuals held, while it redefined the future dominion's independent judiciary. As we turn towards 2026, cosmic synchronicity may recycle some similar episode of the nation's shared inheritance, requiring Canadians to once again put form and function to society's visionary dreams. Saturn conjunct Neptune, eh?

Electional Astrology

Listing a House

I am especially drawn to the branch of electional astrology. Back in January I had the opportunity to pick the time for selling a house in Barrie, Ontario. With the desired chart in hand, we met with the realtor on January 13th.

The seller was asking \$349,900. The realtor felt \$339,900 would be a quicker sale due to the age (built 1997), wear and tear. I felt the art of timing would trump that small issue and insisted the house be listed at the price the seller wanted.

Using the Sprite program on my Apple computer I had narrowed it down to list on February 14th, 2016 at 1:56pm, Sunday, Valentine's Day.

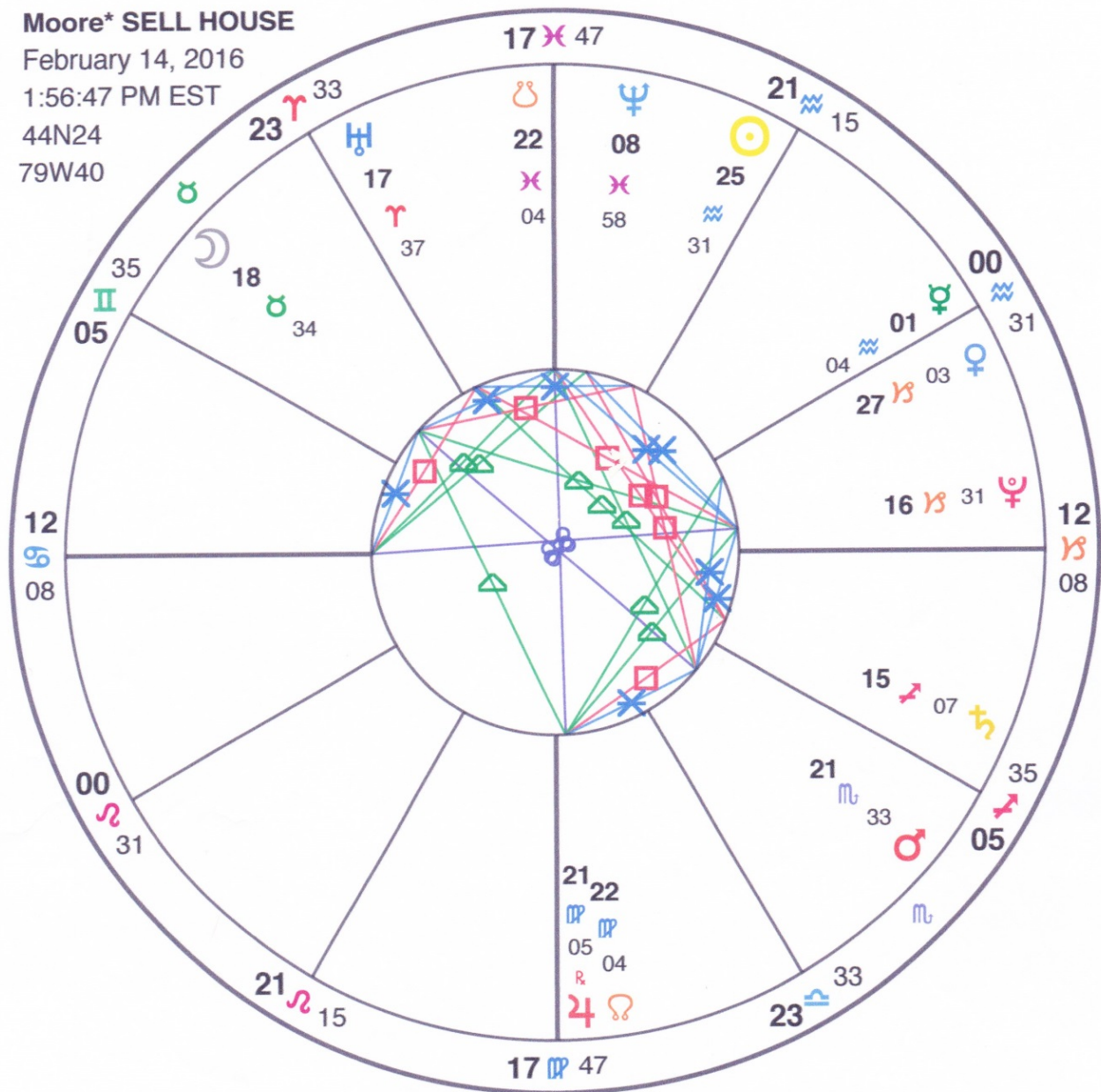
No chart will be perfect but when weighing the strengths and weaknesses, as an astrologer you will be able to base your decision on your knowledge and intuition. Here is a brief summary of a successful

election chart.

The Moon is always the primary significator in electional work. First, check the ephemeris for a positive placement and aspects to other planets. Avoid Moon in Scorpio (fall) and Capricorn (detriment).

For listing a house, try to place the Moon in Cancer or Taurus (exaltation). The Moon should be well aspected, especially by planets concerning the event (Saturn for home listing).

- On Feb 14th we have Moon in Taurus, free of VOC, applying to Jupiter. We also have an opposition to Mars, a square to the Sun however the Grand Trine involving the Moon, Pluto, Jupiter and a midpoint sextile to the ASC /MC made this chart look promising.
- Next, the appropriate ascending sign, here we have Cancer, one's home.
- The seller is represented by the ascendant and its ruler. The descendant represents the probable buyer.
- You must have good aspects between these two rulers to achieve agreement. Here we have the Moon making a separating inconjunct to Saturn, ruler of the 7th and the planet concerning the matter of real estate, selling and



buying. This may possibly mean adjustments to the original contract. Saturn makes a trine to Uranus, ruler of the 8th (money exchange) but squaring Jupiter in the 4th. The buyer's ruler may pose some challenges.

- The Taurean Moon's ruler is Venus who is positioned in the 7th house of the buyer, support for the event and Venus in the sign of Capricorn is ruled by Saturn, the matter in question.
- The ruler of the 4th (home) Mercury is conjunct Venus. Mercury the ruler of legal documents and agreements should be strong, direct and well aspected to Venus being the 'natural ruler' of the 7th (Libra).
- We have the planet Jupiter (luck) placed in the 4th house of the matter, well aspected, part of the Grand Trine and Jupiter receives an applying trine from Venus, the ruler of Taurus.
- The rulers of the 1st Moon, 4th Mercury, 7th Saturn are direct in motion.

chart were convincing enough for me to choose this date and time.

The house sold the following Saturday, February 20th at 5:55pm to a woman of 72 years of age (Saturn) for the asking price, no amendments to the original contract required.

What a great feeling to see astrology work!

If possible place the Sun, Moon, Venus and Jupiter above the horizon and keep the malefic planets out of the angular houses. This was tough but I felt that the benefactors far outweighed the negative aspects and that the planetary connections and strengths in this



Ask An Astrologer

A client's husband had a chronic health condition. It worsened and he had to be hospitalized. While there, he fell, hit his head and died. My client wondered what was happening in her chart when her husband passed away?

Her Progressed Moon was conjuncting Progressed Mercury, ruler of her 12th houses of hospitals. Progressed Mars (ruler of her 8th house of joint finances) was conjuncting her Sun. Transiting Mars was opposing natal Saturn (located in her 2nd house). Saturn rules the 4th house of her home. The transiting Midheaven was conjuncting Pluto and the transiting Ascendant was conjuncting her Progressed Ascendant.

Her two Ascendants were conjuncting her natal Mars, ruler of her 8th house of joint finances, death, insurance and inheritances. Saturn (in the sky) was squaring her Natal Moon, ruler of her 10th house (change in life's direction). Transiting Mercury was conjuncting her Midheaven and squaring her natal Ascendant.

The month before her husband's death, Uranus had moved over her Descendant and was now moving through her 7th house of partnerships. Since her husband's death came "out of the blue", she had no time to prepare for it. Three weeks prior to her husband's death, Jupiter had entered her 8th house. She now had to delve into 8th house matters of joint finances, death, insurance and inheritance.

There is a lot going on in the person's chart when a life-changing event like this occurs.

Other teachers, enrolled on our website, are also getting ready for their new classes this Fall.

It's a long journey from going to your first Astrology Class to becoming an Astrologer. Never forget that "a journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step". When I first started taking classes, I knew I could not work on Astrology seven days a week and not get paid for some of my time. Eighteen months after my first class, I received my first payment for a birth chart interpretation. The next year I registered my Astrology Business. I did a lot of networking in those early years with women's groups. It felt really strange to stand up in front of a large number of people and say "My name is Joan Ann Evelyn and I am an Astrologer". Today, it's totally normal.

Edward Snow writes about Dr Laura Tadd in Astrology News Service. She earned a PhD in Human Science from Saybrook University in Oakland, California. Her doctoral thesis explored the reason why being an astrologer is such a challenge in today's world. She states "It's easier to be an Astrologer today than 100 years ago". Her research indicates that there is a more mainstream acceptance of Astrology than at any time in recent history and a growing number of Astrologers are earning advanced degrees. The Internet has been a great help in promoting Astrology. I was fortunate to attend one of Richard Tarnas' workshops. He is the author of "Cosmos and Psyche". Richard mentioned that many MBA's are leaving the University of California in Berkeley, CA with a comprehensive knowledge of Astrology.

I really enjoy reading Ray Merriman's Newsletters.
